During April's regular HOA meeting, an update was provided. A Neighborhood watch program would not only help to prevent crimes, but could also be instrumental in controlling unlawful traffic violations and any other acts detrimental to our homes and property. Needless to say, it would add significant value to our neighborhood.

In order for the city and Crime Prevention unit to support our efforts, we need to demonstrate at least 25% of our homeowner's support for the program. In addition to the homeowner's involvement, the program must include an annual presentation by the Crime Prevention unit, and a "National Night Out" with law enforcement's participation. Officer Turner's presentation in January, qualifies as the presentation for 2022. Further details will be provided for the Night Out event, held in Texas on October 4 in 2022.
